Booking Terms & Conditions

1. Booking Confirmation

A booking is confirmed upon receipt of the agreed deposit and written confirmation from both parties.

Payment details are provided on the accompanying invoice.

2. Performance Requirements

The Client agrees to provide the following minimum requirements:

- **Power:** A minimum dedicated **30kVA generator** or equivalent clean mains power supply suitable for professional audio, lighting and video production.
- **Stage Size:** Minimum **7 metres wide x 2.4 metres deep.**
- **Stage Height:** The performance stage must be a minimum of **1 metre high.**
- **Stage Cover:** A **covered Pantech stage** (or equivalent covered stage) providing adequate weather protection for performers and equipment.
- **Stage Access:** Safe front access stairs.

The Barnyard Band reserves the right to delay or refuse setup where these minimum requirements are not met.

3. Smoke & Haze Effects

The Barnyard Band incorporates professional smoke and haze effects as part of its live concert production.

The Client is responsible for obtaining all venue approvals and permissions required for the use of smoke and haze effects prior to the performance.

Where smoke or haze is prohibited by the venue or relevant authorities, the performance will proceed without these effects.

4. Drink Rider

An esky is to be positioned on stage **prior to the commencement of the performance** containing:

- Ice
- Bottled water
- Beer

This rider applies to every performance regardless of event duration.

5. Video Production

The Barnyard Band's live production incorporates professionally licensed music videos and visual content displayed via projection systems and/or LED screens.

Visual content is supplied through authorised commercial licensing services, including Xtendamix, and is used in accordance with the applicable licence terms. The Barnyard Band maintains legitimate commercial licences for the visual content used within its production. Any venue or event public performance licensing obligations that may apply remain the responsibility of the event organiser.

6. Sponsorship Obligations

The Barnyard Band maintains contractual obligations with its sponsorship partners.

These sponsorship agreements enable The Barnyard Band to offer a premium concert production at highly competitive pricing and therefore take precedence over any conflicting sponsorship or branding requirements imposed by an event organiser.

Accordingly:

- Sponsor branding displayed on band equipment, stage infrastructure, banners, signage, print material, projection systems or LED displays will **not** be removed, covered or obscured.
 - This applies regardless of whether the event supplies LED screens or The Barnyard Band provides its own projection equipment.
 - Event organisers acknowledge and accept that approved sponsor branding forms part of The Barnyard Band's professional production and presentation.

7. Weather

For outdoor performances, suitable weather protection must be provided for all performers and production equipment.

If weather conditions create an unsafe environment for performers, crew or equipment, The Barnyard Band reserves the right to suspend or cease the performance until conditions are safe.

8. Client Cancellation

Should the Client cancel a confirmed booking:

- Deposits are non-refundable.

- If cancellation occurs **within 30 days** of the scheduled performance date, a minimum of **50% of the total performance fee** becomes immediately payable.
 - This cancellation fee represents compensation for reserving the performance date and the loss of other booking opportunities.
 - This cancellation fee remains payable even where the event is cancelled or cannot proceed due to circumstances outside the Client's control, including but not limited to severe weather, flooding, cyclones, bushfires, road closures, venue closures, government restrictions, public safety directions or other unforeseen events. The reserved performance date cannot generally be rebooked by The Barnyard Band at short notice, and the performance may have been able to proceed had the event been held at an alternative venue or location.

9. Band Cancellation

If The Barnyard Band is unable to perform due to circumstances **within its reasonable control**, any monies paid by the Client will be refunded in full.

Where The Barnyard Band is unable to perform due to circumstances beyond its reasonable control, including but not limited to severe weather, flooding, bushfires, cyclones, road closures, government restrictions, venue closures, power failures, civil emergencies, serious illness or injury, or any other force majeure event, The Barnyard Band shall not be liable for any indirect, consequential or economic loss arising from the cancellation.

10. Limitation of Liability

To the maximum extent permitted by law, The Barnyard Band's total liability arising from any booking shall not exceed the total amount paid by the Client under the booking agreement.

11. Safety

The Barnyard Band reserves the right to suspend or cease a performance where safety is compromised or where abusive, threatening or dangerous behaviour places performers, crew or equipment at risk.

12. Photography & Promotion

The Barnyard Band may photograph, film and record portions of the event for promotional, advertising and social media purposes unless otherwise agreed in writing prior to the performance.

13. Acceptance

Payment of the booking deposit or written acceptance of the quotation constitutes acceptance of these Terms & Conditions.
